





TRI-STATE FORD AWARDS \$132K GRANT TO SUPPORT MOUSE'S INNOVATIVE SEWABLE TECH COURSE

NEW YORK, March 13th, 2018 – <u>Tri-State Ford</u>, in partnership with <u>CBS EcoMedia</u>, has awarded a \$132K grant to bring Sewable Tech learning content to youth across the Tri-State area. Sewable Tech is one of many creative learning courses provided by <u>Mouse</u>, a youth development nonprofit that empowers all students to create with technology and make meaningful change in our world.
